

MESSAGE FROM THE MINISTER
(To Elected Members and CEOs)

PRIVATE PARKING AREAS REGULATIONS

The Regulations under the Private Parking Areas Act were due to expire on 1 September 2002 (refer Gazette 20 August 2001, p3473 to 3476, for the relevant *Subordinate Legislation (Postponement of Expiry) Regulations 2001*).

The Regulations have been remade and Gazetted on 13 December 2001 to come into operation immediately.

The numbering of the Regulations has been altered as a result of provision for revocation and commencement.

A minor substantive amendment has been made to the provision for further offences, now contained in Regulation 12. The former regulation 10 provided that if a motor vehicle is parked in a private parking area in contravention of the Act or regulations, a further offence occurs for each hour that the offence continues. This has been altered so that in the case of an offence of being parked for longer than a permitted period of less than one hour, a further offence occurs for each such period that the offence continues.
